
NOTICE OF HEARING ON OBJECTIONS TO EXEMPTIONS¹

Notice is hereby given that a hearing will be conducted by the undersigned on **Tuesday, March 25, 2008 at 9:00** in the Pecos Courtroom, 4th floor, Pete V. Domenici U.S. Courthouse, 333 Lomas Blvd., N.W., Albuquerque, New Mexico.

The United States asserts that Plaintiffs/Debtors, William H. Payne and Arthur R. Morales, failed to file objections as provided by 28 U.S.C. § 3205(c)(5). However, the garnishee, Sandia Laboratory Federal Credit Union submitted, as an appendix/supplement to its answer, the Plaintiffs/Debtors' affidavits [Doc. 133].

¹This matter is before the Court on an Order of Reference [Doc. 141] from the trial judge, the Honorable M. Christina Armijo directing the undersigned Chief Magistrate Judge "to conduct hearings, as necessary, including evidentiary hearings, and to perform any legal analysis required to recommend to the Court an ultimate disposition" relating to the writs of garnishment in this case. 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B).

Accordingly a hearing will be conducted pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 3014 (b)(2) on the applicability of any exemptions claimed.
